The Anthony K. Baker Internship program is named in honor of the late Anthony K. Baker, a dedicated advocate of historic preservation, history and architecture throughout the United States. The Foundation is looking for graduate and undergraduate students studying architectural design and/or historic preservation to participate in a six-week program this summer. Interning students will be exposed to challenging, professional opportunities while working in the offices of leading architectural, interior, and landscape design firms, assisting with documentation of historic properties, and participating in urban planning and design, as well as a variety of other related projects. A \$1000 stipend will be included with the internship and housing provided.

Grade point average greater than 3.0 (with flexibility)

Commitment to the program beginning on June 12 through July 21, 2017

Stipend of \$1000, housing provided
