

CONNOR MORAN CHILDREN'S CANCER FOUNDATION

Connor Moran Children's Cancer Foundation offers client stabilization funds (financial support) to assist children with cancer and their families, as well as adult cancer patients who have dependent children; who demonstrate need. CMCCF provides eligible clients with up to \$700.00 per year to help offset the costs of general life needs and household expenses, as they relate to a cancer diagnosis and treatment. Client Stabilization Funds are available pending availability of such funds. Our ability to provide financial assistance is made possible because of generous donors and fundraising events. CMCCF reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to modify the policy at any time without notice. Applicants will not be discriminated against or denied aid because of race, ethnicity, religion, color, national origin, immigration status, gender, sexual orientation, disability or political affiliation. Each financial assistance request will be reviewed on a case by case basis. The purpose of this program is to stabilize, help and empower a family with a hardship created because of a medical crisis. Final determination is always made based upon the need, and availability of funds.

COVERED EXPENSES

The program will reimburse applicants up to \$700.00 per year for costs related to their/children's cancer treatments that are not covered by her/his insurance, including:

- Prescription medication expenses not covered by insurance.
- At risk household expenses such as utility, phone (some restrictions apply), rent or mortgage payments, car payments, health/car insurance payments.

- Gas, through provision of gas cards, to cover costs of transportation to and from the doctor's or doctors' office(s), treatment centers, hospitals, and clinics.
- Meals/food/groceries.

NON- COVERED EXPENSES

- Essential dental care for patient, and home/vehicle repairs are not a covered expense as we have community relationships that are able to provide this service at free or sliding scale.
- Travel expenses, such as airline tickets, public transportation, parking fees and tolls and lodging/meals during treatment are not a covered expense as they are an expense addressed by NCCS National Children's Cancer Society and/or other organizations.
- Bereavement expenses including funeral costs, bereavement camp (transportation), and/or a memorial service, however we can manage these arrangements often securing a greatly discounted cost and/or donation.

Respite Care such as restaurant gift cards for family "night out" or parents' date night are not covered, because typically these can be obtained through a request to the establishment.

- CMCCF does not assist with medical expenses outside of the U.S. and/or its territories.
- Funds are not provided for continuing long-term assistance commitments and are never given directly to a family.

ADDITIONALLY, we maintain affiliations and referral relationships with many other support organizations to help manage a family financially whenever possible, over and about our \$700.00 annual assistance.

CARE TO SHARE –DIRECT DONATION Program is for families who require long term or aggressive treatment, are in the late stages of failed treatment, or demonstrate a severe financial hardship. Guidelines for this program are available upon request.
